NACIL has a mixed fleet of narrow body and wide body Airbus, Boeing and Regional Jets. NACIL operates these airplanes in both Domestic and International sectors in Pax and Freighter Configurations under the brand name of AIR INDIA. Our maintenance facilities are located in Mumbai, Delhi, Calcutta and Hyderabad. The maintenance facilities are approved by DGCA of India. Engine overhaul and associated component overhaul facilities are approved by FAA and EASA apart from Indian DGCA..

PURPOSE

NACIL intends to offer upto three B777-200 LR airplanes (Yr 2007 manufacture) on dry lease either for short or long term duration. These airplanes are on a US Exim Guaranteed financing and are being offered as Sub Lease. The Lease will be subject to the prior written consent of US Exim Bank.

These airplanes are maintained per Indian DGCA regulations/ requirements.

OFFER DOCUMENT

The purpose of this document is to present the details of our offer and to invite **Quote** from Airlines / Operators/ Air Cargo Companies or their authorized representatives to drylease these aircraft from NACIL..

PROCESS

After receipt of Quote from Interested parties, NACIL would evaluate the capability of the interested parties to ascertain its ability to

- (i) Maintain and operate the aircraft i.e. exhibit capability to accomplish Line Checks and Lower than C check and
- (ii) Service the Rentals and other payment obligations.

Aircraft would be dryleased to the Bidder offering Best Terms.

SUBMISSION

The Bidder/ Operator (Lessee) shall submit their details/quotation in two separate sealed envelopes.

The first envelope will contain Bidder/ Operator (Lessee) details as per Annexure I and Integrity Pact (duly signed) as per Annexure II and be super scribed as “B777 RFQ – LESSEE DETAILS & INTEGRITY PACT”.

The second envelope will contain Rental Quote as per Annexure III and be super scribed as “B777 RFQ – RENTAL QUOTE”.

The quotation shall be for Monthly Rental per aircraft in USD. The quotation shall be based on the conditions/parameters in Annexure IV.

Bids not submitted with all the above information/documents listed in the prescribed form are liable to be rejected.

The Lessee who intends to lease the aircraft will be permitted, if desired (with prior intimation), to carry out initial inspection of aircraft and documents at Mumbai (at Lessee's cost).
